This survey was developed based on Epstein's Six Types of Involvement in School, Family, and Community Partnerships. The six types of involvement in schools make up the following six facets of the survey:

1. **Parenting** – helping all families establish a home environment to support their children as students
2. **Communicating** – designing effective forms of school-to-home and home-to-school communications about school programs and student progress
3. **Volunteering** – recruiting and organizing parent help and support
4. **Learning at Home** – providing information and ideas to families about how to help students at home with homework and other curriculum-related activities, decisions, and planning
5. **Decision Making** – including parents in school decisions, developing parent leaders and representatives
6. **Collaborating with the Community** – identifying and integrating resources and services from the community to strengthen school programs, family practices, and student learning and development
